#### **Chair's Update**

SBC have again cancelled the PC Chairs meeting with no explanation – however they have invited all PC Chairs to a Parent Council Fair on 13th June at Inspire, Tweedbank, so I'll report back on what that event achieves.

I spoke as part of the recent PHS presentation to SBC's Education Committee regarding follow up actions after the external inspection. The Committee Chair thanked the Parent Council for their efforts and noted the high level of knowledge in relation to our school community.

The PC inbox is receiving far fewer admin-related enquiries and I have received a couple of suggestions that I'll cover in AOB.

Alex Corbishley gave the following update on the University Aspirations Group:

- Many thanks to Ruth Doherty who is stepping down from the group. Ruth is a Professor of Atmospheric Sciences at the University of Edinburgh and founded the group a number of years ago to support young people at PHS wishing to apply for courses with an October UCAS deadline. We are hugely grateful for her tireless input over the years.
- The group would be appreciative of any support that members of our community are able to provide. We would particularly welcome support from anyone with a background in dentistry, mathematics/engineering/physics and the humanities.
- Last year PHS put forward one applicant for veterinary medicine, two for Cambridge, two for Oxford and three for medicine. All the veterinary and medicine applicants were successful and half the Oxbridge applicants were successful. This is an impressive success rate, but is a relatively low rate of applications for these prestigious programmes given the school's headline academic performance and catchment area.
- Mairi Stark and Alex Corbishley will be going to speak to the new S6 cohort on 3<sup>rd</sup> June to encourage them to be ambitious with their University applications. We are also looking for a suitable lunchtime before the summer break where we can talk to potentially interested S6 pupils.
- We would like to hear from the school what work it is undertaking to support its high achieving S3/4/5 pupils to be ambitious with their University applications. Particularly those young people who are LEAPS eligible (https://www.leapsonline.org/)

There was a discussion about LEAPS, the school needs to identify these young people – school has a better tracking system now that can identify LEAPS eligible young people. And could target those young people, and perhaps write to those parents.

There was a discussion around the speaker at this year's prize giving, who could be inspirational for all young people, not just those attending prize giving - could this be made accessible to all? The Head agreed this was a good point, and we could be thinking about inspirational speakers for assemblies.

Chair is attending the Plan for Peebles consultation – please email if there's anything you would like raised.

#### **Headteacher's Update**

Head shared 'One Peebles' presentation which was shared with staff at the recent Inset day and the Education Subcommittee (referred to above). See below:





Re Pupil Voice - once a month pupils are invited to put questions to the Head and they are answered. They can be on any topic around the school.

#### How did consistency of the learning experience show in the survey?

I've still to really look at all the results. The focus is on empowering the middle leadership at the moment.

New Build - we have asked for bike storage. We're getting a 400m running track on the other side of Craigerne Lane, rugby pitches.

There is a new course being offered we are excited about: Mountain Biking Level 5 for S5 and S6.

#### Parents don't know what the Levels mean

We can put an explanation of the levels on the website. S1 - 3 reports will have grades on them next year. Planning in S1 - 3 (BGE) will consist of teachers doing planning sheets, and having a more holistic approach.

#### Action – Explanation of Education Levels to be put on school website

There was a discussion around levels, reporting and Showbie. Parents want to know what level their child is working at, should they be at that level, what do they need to do to improve, consistency of feedback on Showbie, evaluated by teacher (not pupil).

#### S2 reports – physics was missing and we have not yet had reporting on physics?

Yes I'll look into that.

#### Re the behaviour policy – have you noticed an improvement?

There is good feedback from pupils, staff, calmer, nicer atmosphere, more relaxed. So yes, anecdotally. I'm certain it's better, we need to never take our eye off it. Do we need consistency in classes, yes. There is better guidance on consequences of bad behaviour. There are exclusions and detentions. Nobody leaves without their dignity intact.

# Timetables – if young people haven't got the subjects they chose, have they been notified? Worth communicating that?

Yes, they have been. We will let all know that they have their choices.

#### **Parent Council Survey**

Alex Corbishley presented the results of the PC survey (see appendix)

Parent response was much lower this year. Context of the history of this survey was discussed. At the time it was introduced, there was more engagement of parents at PC meetings as they were online. There was some frustration around trying to get data from the school that was not shared (it was obtained through a FOI request).

The Head appreciated the fact the survey was done as the data is useful. Would be interested to see the free text. The school should give you this information so the PC shouldn't need to do this. Recognition we need to be wary of parents (and pupils) being 'over-surveyed' (HMI survey; SBC survey; PC survey)

Future Planning – there was discussion around when we run this survey again (March is same time as SBC survey). Maybe we use it at a point in time, not necessarily March? Head would prefer not to run this survey; staff are wary of the PC survey, and I am not sure if they have been followed up with staff. We need to build bridges between teachers & parents. The relationship we have with PC is vital. Recognition from Head that the school needs to get better at telling parents if young people are struggling earlier on in the year, so no surprises at report/parents nights.











## For each statement in the grid below, please indicate how strongly you agree or disagree
