#### Contribute - Grow

- I **give back** to our school community by undertaking volunteering in PHS or in the community.
- I contribute fully to the **S6 wider team** in a positive and constructive way.
- I look after the **Reading Room and library**. The Reading Rooms is a silent space, I have work to do and I respect the rules about eating, drinking and litter.

#### Work hard - Achieve

- I **attend** all my classes including all PSE lessons for the whole session.
- I maintain a **full timetable** which includes signing in and out of the library and school at the agreed times.
- I meet all my **deadlines** including Home Study Agreements.

I understand that not following the above expectations may mean that I will not be allowed to attend school events such as Christmas Dance, Burns Supper, Graduation and Prom.
